Operation quit

You will be aware of our 'Stop before the Op' campaign and will have seen the specific leaflets and posters around the waiting rooms which have been delivered to your surgeries over the last few months. This is to highlight to patients the importance of stopping smoking prior to surgery.

The Royal College of Anaesthetists suggests quitting two months prior to surgery provides the most benefit. The time around surgery is considered 'a teachable moment' by experts and temporary abstinence before surgery can lead to a permanent quit, especially if the person is supported by referral to stop smoking services.

We have referral pathways set up with both the Royal Berkshire Hospital and Wexham Park Hospital, however the earlier the referral can be made, the better. This is why Clinicians in primary care are very well placed to make the referral for stop smoking support at the same time as making the referral to the Hospital.

Referrals can be made in the usual way in which your surgery refers to Smokefreelife Berkshire.



Key Facts

Wound necrosis after mastectomy is four times more frequent in smokers than non-smokers

Quitting prior to surgery reduces wound-related complications

Perioperative smoking cessation decreases wound healing time

Evidence suggests quitting two months prior to surgery offers the optimum benefit as it gives time for the body to recover from some of the shortterm effects of smoking such as carbon monoxide binding

Studies suggest that smokers have two to 10 times the risk of wound problems and non-union of fractures after surgery
